We are pleased to offer a limited number of IFCC Travel Scholarships designated to allow young scientists from selected countries to attend the IFCC WORLDLAB 2017 to be held in Durban, South Africa, from 22 to 25 October 2017.

Applicants should be less than 40y of age on 1 January 2017; first time to be awarded an IFCC scholarship; supported/selected by IFCC members; priority will be given to applicants submitting an abstract.

The IFCC Travel Scholarship will provide funding towards:

- 1) cost of economy travel - original receipts needed for refund;
- 2) up to 4 nights hotel BB accommodation - original receipts needed for refund;
- 3) free registration for the congress.

Scholarships will be paid after the congress on provision of evidence of the congress attendance.

Successful applicants will be required to write an account of their experience.

Applicants are required to complete the application form that can be obtained from the IFCC Office (ifcc@ifcc.org). The completed application and the supporting documents should be sent by email to the IFCC Office **by 30th June 2017**.
